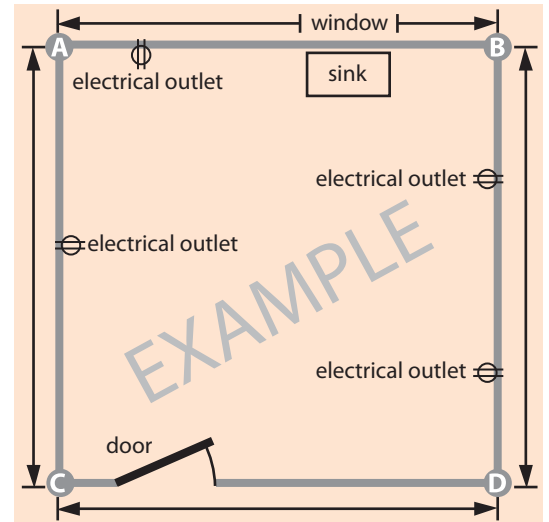


trace the plan of your current kitchen

1. Using the grid below, trace a detailed plan of your current kitchen.
2. Take precise measurements from one corner of the room to the next.
3. For each wall, note the height and width of doors and windows (including frames), as well as their locations.
4. Note the location of plumbing, electrical outlets and fan outlet, always from the middle of each item.
5. Note any other constraint such as stairs, ramps or other obstacles.
6. Specify the height of the ceiling: _____
